

Emissions Data

***Old stove emissions before 1988 were typically between 20—80 g/hr.**

***Some old stoves with air tight doors and no secondary combustion produced up to 200 g/hr.**

***Up to 65% of wood's weight can be converted to hydrocarbons that produce particulates if not burned.**

***EPA Certified Stoves must produce less than 7.5 g/hr. (4.1 g/h for catalytic stoves).**

Most stoves now produce 2-4 g/hr.
